SUBJECT: HTF Program Income Limits – 2024

This memorandum issues the 2024 Housing Trust Fund (HTF) Program Income Limits for all HTF grantees, which are effective for the HTF Program on June 1, 2024. The HTF Program Income Limits were updated for 2024 by HUD's Program Parameters and Research Division, Office of Policy Development and Research (PD&R). A complete set of the 2024 HTF Program Income Limits, grouped by state, is posted at: https://www.huduser.gov/portal/datasets/HTF-Income-limits.html.

The income targeting requirements for the HTF Program, found at 24 CFR 93.250, state that in any fiscal year in which the total amount available for allocation of HTF funds is less than \$1 billion, the grantee must use 100 percent of its HTF grant for the benefit of extremely low-income families or families with incomes at or below the poverty line (whichever is greater). In any fiscal year in which the total amount available for allocation of HTF funds is greater than \$1 billion, the grantee must use at least 75 percent of its grant for the benefit of extremely low-income families or families with incomes at or below the poverty line.

The 2024 HTF Program Income Limits provide 30 percent limits, which may be different than the extremely low-income limits for the Section 8 Program, and the Poverty Guideline Limits.

Please make sure HTF grantees under your Field Office are notified of the issuance and effective date of the 2024 HTF Program Income Limits. If you have any questions regarding these limits, please contact your Desk Officer in the Office of Affordable Housing Programs.



SUBJECT: HTF Program Rent Limits – 2024

This memorandum issues the 2024 Housing Trust Fund (HTF) Program Rent Limits for all HTF grantees, which are effective for the HTF Program on June 1, 2024. The HTF Program Rent Limits were updated for 2024 by HUD's Program Parameters and Research Division, Office of Policy Development and Research (PD&R). The 2024 HTF Program Rent Limits are the maximum amount that may be charged for rent in HTF-assisted rental units and are applicable to new HTF leases and lease renewals after that date. A complete set of the 2024 HTF Program Rent Limits grouped by state is posted at: https://www.huduser.gov/portal/datasets/HTF-Rent-limits.html.

The maximum HTF Program Rent Limits are established in 24 CFR 93.302(b). The HTF rent plus utilities of an extremely low-income tenant shall not exceed the greater of 30 percent of the federal poverty line or 30 percent of the income of a family whose annual income equals 30 percent of the median income for the area, as determined by HUD, with adjustments for the number of bedrooms in the unit. The HTF rent plus utilities of a very low-income tenant shall not exceed 30 percent of the income of a family whose annual income equals 50 percent of the median income for the area, as determined by HUD, with adjustments for the number of bedrooms in the unit. HUD will publish the HTF Program Rent Limits on an annual basis.

For information only, the HTF Program Rent Limit worksheets include the 30 percent rent limits and the Poverty Guideline Rent. HUD is providing this information so that grantees will know which of the "greater of" standards has been applied.

Please make sure HTF grantees under your Field Office are notified of the issuance and effective date of the 2024 HTF Program Rent Limits. If you have any questions regarding these limits, please contact your Desk Officer in the Office of Affordable Housing Programs.
